ARTICLE I – TITLE

Great Lakes Area: The states of Ohio, Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Kentucky, New York and Province of Ontario.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

The purpose of the Meet shall be to promote mutual understanding, fraternal and social relationship among the members of organized units.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

All members of organized Units in the Great Lakes Area in good standing in the Ladies Oriental Shrine of North America Inc shall be eligible for membership.

ARTICLE IV – OFFICERS

- A. The officers of the Great Lakes Organized Unit Meets shall be President, First Vice-President, Second-Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.
- B. The Officers shall be elected at each Meet and shall hold office until their successors have been elected and installed at the next Great Lakes Unit Meet.
- C. The President, Second-Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be members of the Hostess Court. The First Vice President shall be a member of the Traveling Unit of the Hostess Court for the following meet.

ARTICLE V – DUTIES OF OFFICERS

- Section 1. The President who shall be an active member of a traveling Unit shall preside at all meetings of the Meet, sign all warrants drawn upon the Treasury, attested by the Secretary, and perform such duties as pertain to the Office of President.

Section 2. The First-Vice President being an active member of a traveling Unit of the Hostess Court of the following Meet, shall be eligible for nomination to the office of president for the following year.

The Second-Vice President, being an active member of a traveling Unit from the same court as the president, shall perform duties similar to the duties performed by the President and in the absence of the President, shall perform such duties as are incumbent upon the office of the President, but shall not be eligible for nomination of President for the succeeding year.

Section 3. The Secretary shall keep a true record of all transactions of meetings of the Meet, shall collect all monies due the Meet as may hereafter be specified, and perform such other duties as the office may require.

Section 4. The Treasurer shall issue all checks, pay all bills and keep an accurate record of all monies and give receipt to the Secretary for same.

ARTICLE VI – LAWS

Section 1. Organized Units, Ladies Oriental Shrine of North America, Inc., shall conform to the laws of the Grand Council, LOSNA, Inc., and the laws of Subordinate Courts in which they hold membership.

Section 2. A letter must be sent to the current Grand High Priestess, and the Grand Officer who will be the Grand High Priestess in the year of the Meet. A dispensation must be procured from the Grand Recorder when the date is set for the Unit Meet. \$2.00 to be paid to the Court Recorder for same Dispensation to be read prior to Business Meeting of Unit Meet.

Section 3. The meet shall not in any manner, be an obligation to the Court. The High Priestess of the Court of the Hostess Units shall, by virtue of her office, be named Chairman Ex-Officio.

Section 4. (A) The Lady Gladys Abbott meeting will be held Friday of the Great Lakes Unit Meet. Invitations are to be sent to all Past Presidents, Elected Officers, and Officers-Elect of Courts with accepted GLUM bids. Grand High Priestess, Grand Officers and Past Grand Officers attending GLUM will also be extended an invitation to the meeting. All ladies will be notified of the time and place.

(B) A meeting of the general membership of the Great Lakes Unit Meet will be held on Friday of the Meet. Time to be designated by the Hostess Court. To be admitted to the meeting you must show your current dues card, or your registration badge.

Section 5. The Hostess Units shall devise ways and means to liquidate all financial obligations of the Meet.

Section 6. All members of registered organized Units are permitted to participate in exhibition performance which is strictly non-competitive.

- Section 7. Members of the Order, families and friends are invited to attend the exhibitions.
- Section 8. (A) Registration fee shall be specified by the Hostess Units. All members MUST pre-register. All pre-registrations postmarked after the deadline are subject to a \$10.00 non-refundable late charge. \$2.00 of each registration is to be sent to the Grand Council.
- (B) Any unit or attendee requesting a receipt must include a self-addressed stamped envelope with their pre-registration payment.
- (C) Non-members and guests of members shall not be required to pay a registration fee. They will not be able to attend the Lady Gladys Abbott Meeting of GLUM Business Meeting; however; they may attend all other social functions and pay the appropriate charge as set by the Hostess Court. This regulation does not apply to LOSNA members who must register to attend any and all functions of the Great Lakes Unit Meet. The Hostess Court will provide a name badge to visitors, distinguishable from the name badges provided to members.
- Section 9. (A) Great Lakes Unit Meet shall not be held at the time of Ceremonial of Hostess Court.
- (B) Places and dates for Great Lakes Unit Meets shall be scheduled for a five (5) year period starting in 1980.
- (C) Unit Meet to be held on the last weekend in September beginning in 1985. (Canada's Thanksgiving is the second Monday in October.)
- Section 10. Grand Directress must be a Past Grand High Priestess or Grand Officer. The Grand Directress to be elected by the Hostess Units. A Grand Directress shall not serve more than two (2) consecutive years. The Hostess Court shall provide hotel accommodations for the Grand Directress for three (3) nights.
- Section 11. The Hostess Court shall provide hotel accommodations for the Grand High Priestess, (if she attends) for the nights she is in attendance, not to exceed three (3) nights.
- Section 12. Upon request of an individual Courts High Priestess, any Past President of the Great Lakes Unit Meet of said court may be escorted by her High Priestess to the East to stand as said Court Units perform.

ARTICLE VII – CANCELLATIONS

- A. All cancellations not received twenty-one (21) days prior to the Unit Meet will forfeit Registration fee. All cancellations are subject to a \$5.00 handling fee.
- B. In the event of the death of a Past Grand High Priestess, Grand officer, or High Priestess of registrant's home court, cancellations will be accepted during the twenty-one (21) day period prior to the Meet. Half of the registration fee will be refunded. 

ARTICLE VIII – HOSTESS COURTS

Initial Hostess Courts for Great Lakes Unit Meets will be recognized first when all courts in the area have Served as hostess.

ARTICLE IX – PERFORMANCE DRAWINGS

- A. One representative from each Unit MUST attend the Unit drawing in order to be eligible to perform in the drills.
- B. The Units of the Hostess Court will perform first. The order shall be determined by the Units of the Hostess Court.

The Units of the Court Hosting the next year will perform second. The order shall be determined by the Units of the next Court to Hostess the next Unit Meet.

The first round of the draw shall consist of one Unit from each Court participating in the Unit Meet. The Units of each court shall determine which of their Units will draw in the first round. This selection must be done prior to presenting themselves for the draw and only the Unit of each Court that is drawing in the first round will be allowed to approach the table. The first-round draw will be done in Court number order.

- C. The timing of five (5) minutes will start after the last person of the Unit goes over the designated Line on the floor.
- D. Massing of Colors by Court Number.

ARTICLE X – EXHIBITION FLOOR

- A. Hostess Court must have an exhibition floor with non-carpeted floor no less than 36' x 36' and that time will be allowed for practice on that floor. (Amended 9/26/08) but not effective until the year 2013.

(Note: on 9/26/08 the currently effective floor size was waived to no less than 36' x 36' for Courts holding a GLUM in the years 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012.)

- B. Floor plan of exhibition floor with exits and entrances marked are to be sent in the packets.

ARTICLE XI – OFFICIAL INSIGNIA AND TRAVELING BANNER

- A. At the closing of each Great Lakes Unit Meet, the immediate Past President of the Great Lakes Unit Meet will give the original Great Lakes Unit Meet official Insignia, which is 37" in diameter, and the Great Lakes Unit Meet traveling banner which is approximately 33" wide and 71" long, to the newly elected President of the Great Lakes Unit Meet. This transaction shall be recorded at the end of the minutes, and recipients shall sign for same.
- B. The official Insignia and traveling banner of the Great Lakes Unit Meet shall be transferred by the immediate Past President to the newly elected president of the Great Lakes Unit Meet at the Massing of the Colors of the current Great Lakes Unit Meet.
